FILMMAKING: GERMANY 25 REUNIFIED

This was a large video and photo project I co-produced for the German National Tourism Board. We created 20+ videos telling stories of reunification from across the country, after the wall had fallen 25 years prior. These are very cinematic pieces, and showcase my filmmaking.
